Course Overview

Every person lives and leads out their foundational theological convictions, whether they realize it or not. A fruitful life of discipleship and mission requires that you possess the theological clarity to contextualize the Gospel, faithfully explain the Bible, disciple confused and mature believers, and gently correct false teaching. This course will deepen your theological development so that your life, ministry, and church are planted in a healthy foundation.

Course Objectives

This course aims to teach and develop participants in the following key areas and objectives:

- **God.** Participants will develop a clear understanding of the importance of God's Triune nature as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- **Humanity.** Participants will develop an understanding of the beauty and distinctions between God's image bearers, men and women.
- **The Gospel.** Participants will develop a foundational view of the gospel's centrality in life and ministry.
- **Salvation** (*doctrines of grace*). Participants will examine and develop a biblical understanding of God's role and sovereignty in salvation.
- **The Church.** Participants will develop a robust theology of the church and its mission.
- **Humility in Theology.** Participants will grow in their ability to hold theological convictions with clarity and humility
